Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to the respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that so far as the prayer of petitioner No.1 Navdeep Kaur to protect her life and liberty is concerned, she is in the custody of her parents and, therefore, he does not press this petition qua her.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed as not pressed qua petitioner No.1 Navdeep Kaur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner No.2 further states that petitioner No.2 Ninder Singh is still apprehending threats at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 7.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Rana Harjasdeep Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

In view of the above, without making any observation on the claim so projected by the petitioner No.2 including the validity of the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioner No.2 at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 7.
