This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.349 dated 09.10.2017, registered at Police Station Ambala Cantt., Ambala, under Section 72 of Information Technology Act, 2000 and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Pursuant to order dated 21.12.2017, report dated 18.01.2018, has been received from Sh. Vijayant Sehgal, Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ambala, according to which, the statements of the parties have been recorded and the compromise is genuine and has been arrived at between them without any pressure or coercion.

None is present on behalf of respondent No.2 today, although, Mr. S.S. Sisodia, Advocate, had put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2 on 21.12.2017.

In view of the fact that the parties have amicably resolved the dispute between them, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.349 dated

09.10.2017, registered at Police Station Ambala Cantt., Ambala, under Section 72 of Information Technology Act, 2000 alongwith all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, is quashed.
