This application has been preferred by the applicant-petitioner

Darshan Singh, father of minor child namely Samardeep Singh, for

releasing the draft of Rs.2,00,000/- which has been deposited by him

with the Registry of this Court, in terms of the order passed by this Court

on 20.2.2018.

The wife of applicant-petitioner had expired in the year

2014 and the minor son is being brought up by his maternal grand

parents. The dispute regarding custody of the minor child was resolved

with the efforts of Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and

the parties have entered into settlement on 10.5.2018. A copy of the

settlement is annexed at Annexure 'A'.

Learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner submits that in

terms of the settlement arrived at between the parties with regard to

upbringing of the minor namely Samardeep Singh, a demand draft of

Rs.2,00,000/- which was deposited by him with the Registry, was to be

converted into an FDR in favour of the minor son. He also contends that

FDR for another sum of Rs.2,00,000/- has already been made in favour

of the minor Samardeep Singh under the guardianship of his maternal

grand father, namely Pritam Chand. The FDR in original, has been

handed over to Amarjit Singh, maternal uncle of minor Samardeep

Singh and son of Pritam Chand.

Learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner states that in

pursuance to the order of this Court dated 10.08.2018, applicant--

petitioner has withdrawn an amount of Rs.2 lakh, which had been

deposited by him, with the Registry and he has made two FDRs for Rs.2

lakh each in the name of minor son Samardeep Singh, under the

guardianship of his maternal grand father, Pritam Chand. Copies of the

FDRs, which have been handed over by learned counsel for the

applicant-petitioner, are taken on record.

Admittedly, the applicant-petitioner has made 2 FDRs for

Rs.2 lakh each in the name of his minor son, Samardeep Singh under the

guardianship of his maternal grand father, Pritam Chand.

Therefore, no further orders are called for in this

application, which stands disposed of.
