JASPAL SINGH, J.

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing order dated 28.03.2014 (P-3) passed by respondent No.2 vide which he refused to count the suspension/termination period from 02.11.1989 to 29.03.1996 till his reinstatement as qualifying service for the purpose of pensionary benefits including gratuity, leave encashment and all other retiral benefits.

2. Reply by way of short affidavit of Mr. Gursewak Singh Rajpal, General Manager, Punjab Roadways, Ludhiana on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 has been filed in Court today and same is taken on record.

3. A glance at the reply transpires that order dated 28.02.2018 (R-1) has

already been passed, whereby, the relief sought through instant petition has been granted.

4. In view of the passing of order dated 28.02.2018 (R-1), whereby relief sought by the petitioner has already been granted, the instant petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous
