The petitioners are working in the Government Udyog-shala, Roorkee. According to the documents placed on record dated 27.02.2013, the petitioners were held entitled to the same pay scale, which were being paid to the regularly appointed class IV employees. The petitioners' pay was revised on the recommendation of the 6th Pay Commission. They were paid actual monetary dues w.e.f. 24.03.2011 in stead of 01.01.2006. The respondents have surprisingly taken a stand which is contrary to the record that the petitioners were not Government employees.

There is sufficient material on record including letter dated 27.02.2013 to establish that the petitioners are the Government employees.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State submits that due to the financial crunch, the petitioners were not granted the revised pay scale w.e.f. 01.01.2006, but they were paid w.e.f. 24.03.2011.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that employees of the State Government have also been paid the actual arrears in the year 2008-09.

Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of with the direction to the respondents to consider to pay the actual benefits to the petitioners w.e.f. 2008 on the analogy of the other employees of the State Government within a period of ten weeks from today.
