By means of present writ petition, the petitioner seeks following reliefs:

- i) *To issue a Writ of Mandamus or any other order or direction in the nature thereof commanding respondent no.1 to implement and execute forthwith the order dated 06.11.2017 passed by it.*
- ii) *To issue a Writ of Mandamus or any other writ, order or direction in the nature thereof directing respondent no.2 and 3 to make available requisite police force and maintain law and order at the time of execution of the order dated 06.11.2017 passed by respondent no.1*

As a matter of fact, he wanted to enforce the order dated 06.11.2017 as passed by Secretary, Haridwar-Roorkee Development Authority by virtue of which, while exercising power under Section 28 A(i), the directives were issued to seal the premises of respondent no. 4. It is being stated at bar by Mr. Harihar Gupta that after filing of the writ petition and in compliance with order dated 17.11.2017, the premises have now

been sealed and as a matter of fact, the purpose of filing the writ petition has rendered infructuous. The same may be dismissed as infructuous.

The dismissal of the writ petition as made by this order, as infructuous, may not be considered as closing the avenues of the petitioner in any other independent proceedings.
