This Court by an order /judgment dated 21.09.2017 had allowed the Writ Petition and consequently, recall application as filed before Labour Court was also allowed, with a direction to the Labour Court to decide the case itself within a period of six months from the date of judgment i.e. 21.09.2017. The Registry has received a letter on administrative side on 28.03.2018 whereby the Presiding Officer of Labour Court had made a request for extension of time to comply with the order dated 21.09.2017. Looking to the reasons which has been given to the letter addressed to the Registrar General of this court, this Court though not very happy with the manner in which the Presiding Officer has taken up the matter for the extension of the time. Yet in the wider interest of the justice, this Court extends the time period for a further period of two months from today to comply earlier directions dated 21.09.2017 under no set of circumstances such time extension will be given in future.
