The petitioner was granted a licence to run a foreign liquor shop at Aliganj Road, District Udhampur, however, the petitioner has not been able to run the liquor shop properly and now excise tax/revenue is being recovered from the petitioner. Hence, the petitioner has filed the present writ petition before this Court.

This Court, however, is not inclined to interfere in the present matter. The petitioner is running a liquor shop under certain terms and conditions of a licence and he is unable to run the liquor shop not on account of any action of the part of the State, but for other reasons for which the State cannot be blamed.

In view of the aforesaid, no relief can be granted to the petitioner. The writ petition stands dismissed in limine.
