Counsels are agreed that the issue raised in the present writ petition is covered by the order dated 20.04.2018 passed in various writ petitions including W.P.(C) No.3887/2018, titled: *Prabuddha Choudhury vs. Registrar of Companies and Anr.* In sum, the petitioner seeks to revive the subject company by filing an appeal, if not already filed, before the NCLT under Section 252 of the Companies Act, 2013.

4. Counsel for the petitioner says that qua the subject company i.e., Advent Infotech Pvt. Ltd., he seeks application of the directives contained in
