ORDER 01.05.2018

Present case has been listed in pursuance to an office note.

In the said notice, it has been stated that the date of interim order has been wrongly noted in the last paragraph of the order dated 28<sup>th</sup> February, 2018. Consequently, the order dated 28<sup>th</sup> February, 2018 shall now read as under:-

## "<u>I.A. 2897/2018</u>
