1. Petitioner has filed this bail application under Section 439 of Cr.P.C.
2. F.I.R. No.013/2017 was registered at Police Station Cyber Crime, Jaipur for offence under Sections 419, 420, 406, 468, 471, 120-B I.P.C. and Section 66C, 66D of I.T. Act.
3. It is contended by the counsel for the petitioner that charge-sheet has been filed in this case and trial would consume time. Co-accused has been granted benefit of bail by Co-ordinate Bench and by this Court.
4. Counsel for the complainant has opposed the bail application. His contended is that petitioner is indulging in cyber crime and has withdrawn an amount of 68,50,000/- out of which

19,50,000/- was deposited in the account of the petitioner and with that amount petitioner has purchased gold.

5. Learned Public Prosecutor has also opposed the bail application.

6. Considering the contention of learned counsel for the complainant and learned Public Prosecutor and looking to the gravity of the offence as well as the fact that earlier also petitioner has indulged in similar activities, I am not inclined to grant benefit of bail to the petitioner.

7. The bail application is accordingly rejected.
