This bail application has been filed under Section 438  
CrPC.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is  
working as a Gangman in the Railways and the allegation against  
him is of abducting. Victim Lakhan Singh is also working as a  
Gangman in the Railways. The FIR has been lodged in order to  
save the Lakhan Singh's wife, who is engaged in chit fund  
business and the petitioner claims amount from her as the  
cheques issued have been bounced. It is stated that Lakhan Singh  
has not been abducted and he is living with his father.

Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of  
the case, without commenting further on the merits and  
demerits of the case, I deem it just and proper to grant benefit  
of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, this bail application filed under Section

438 CrPC is allowed and it is directed that in the event of arrest of petitioner Hansram S/o Ramkhiladi, in connection with FIR No. 365/2018 registered at Police Station, Bayana, District Bharatpur, he shall be released on bail by the concerned SHO/Investigating Officer, provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs. 20,000/- (Rs. Twenty Thousand), with two sureties of like amount to his / her satisfaction on the following conditions:

- i) That the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer, as and when required;
- ii) That the petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case, so as to dissuade him/her from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer;
- iii) That the petitioner shall not leave without previous permission of the court;
- iv) That the petitioner shall not commit any offence similar to the offence of which he is accused or suspected.
