1. It is contended by counsel for the appellant that there is a delay of thirteen days in lodging of F.I.R. Appellant was on bail during trial. There is no allegation against the appellant. Disposal of the appeal will take time.
2. Learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the application for suspension of sentence.
3. I have considered the contentions.
4. Considering the same, application for suspension of sentence is allowed.
5. Accordingly, the application for suspension of sentence is allowed. It is ordered that the sentence awarded to accused-

applicant in Sessions Case No.95/2016 shall remain suspended if the appellant furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court to the effect that he shall appear before Deputy Registrar (Judicial) on or before 29.09.2018 and as and when called upon to do so.
