List revised. No one is present to press the present revision.

Present revision has been filed challenging the judgement and order dated 18.5.1999 passed by the Judge, Family Court, Bareilly in Case No. 125/96 (Smt. Sukhdevi vs. Ram Lal) under Section 125 Cr.P.C.

By the impugned order a sum of Rs. 375/- per month has been awarded.

From perusal of record I find that all factual aspects have been asserted that the award is excessive and the application under Section 125 Cr.P.C. was filed to put pressure on the revisionist to transfer the entire property in the name of his wife.

Finding of fact regarding income of the revisionist has been recorded that he has sufficient income to maintain her wife. The other factual assertions were rejected.

On perusal of record I find that the finding has been recorded that the opposite party no. 2 is the legally wedded wife of the revisionist and is unable to maintain herself and the revisionist has sufficient means to maintain her.

Accordingly, I do not find any legal infirmity in the order impugned herein.

Interim order, if any, stands vacated.

Present revision is devoid of merit and is accordingly dismissed.
