Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned counsel for the informant as well as learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 324, 325, 307, 504/34, 302 of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner along with one other FIR named accused is said to have assaulted the deceased by means of sword. The postmortem report of the deceased reveals that multiple fracture was found on the person of the deceased and the aforesaid injuries became cause of death of the deceased.

However, it is informed on behalf of the informant that almost all the prosecution witnesses, except investigating officer

and doctor, have already been examined and there is every likelihood of conclusion of trial of the petitioner in near future.
