Petitioner seeks bail in **Kajra P.S.** Case No.03 of **2019** instituted for the offence under Section(s) 386 Indian Penal Code.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is not named in the First Information Report. No Test Identification Parade has been held. No incriminating article has been recovered from his possession.

It is alleged in the written report that some unknown criminals have made demand of levy from the *Munshi* of the informant.

During investigation, one *naxal parcha* has been recovered from possession of the petitioner and on that basis the

Case No.03 of 2019**, subject to the condition that both the bailors shall be close relative of the petitioner.
