2 31-07-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under
Sections 323, 341, 357, 368, 372, 386, 304B, 498A, 504 &
506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is of committing torture
and caused death of the victim due to non-fulfillment of demand
of dowry.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the
petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation
of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The
petitioner is in custody since 15-02-2019. Charge sheet has
already been submitted. The petitioner has been falsely
implicated in the present case. From perusal of the statement of



witnesses made in paragraphs-5, 6, 7 & 8, it appears that the deceased had caught fire while she was cooking. It is a case of accidental death. No offence u/S 304B of the Indian Penal Code is made out. The son of the petitioner is also residing with the petitioner.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the Complaint Case/F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Dalsingsarai in connection with Sessions Trial No. 230 of 2019 arising out of Ujiarpur P.S. Case No. 242 of 2018.
