Sub Paragraph (iii) of Paragraph 4 of the affidavit recites that as regards encroachment on the land of Khata No. 405, notices were issued against 34 encroachers where 23 pucca houses and shops were existing. Paragraph 5 of the affidavit a prayer has been made to grant three months' time in order to complete the said process.
