[1] None appears for the petitioner. Mr. RK. Umakanta, learned G.A. appears for the respondents.

[2] Prayer in the writ petition reads as follows :

“(i) To issue a writ in the nature of mandamus / certiorari or any other appropriate writ, order or direction, to the respondents to reinstate the petitioner to his former posts/service as L. Naik in the 8th Battalion, Manipur Rifles, Leikun by setting aside the order dated 30.04.1991 of the Commandant, 8th Bn Manipur Rifles, Leikun, Manipur forthwith.”

[3] On many occasions none appeared for the petitioner. Today also when the matter is taken up, none appears for the petitioner.

[4] Mr. RK. Umakanta, learned G.A. appearing for the respondents states that in respect of relief as sought for, the petitioner has got appellate remedy which has not been exhausted.

[5] In this view of the matter, writ petition is disposed of by giving liberty to the petitioner to approach the appellate forum within a period of 4 (four) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
