Petitioners have prayed for following reliefs:

- I. Issue notice upon the respondents,
- II. Call for relevant records from the custody of the Respondents,
- III. Issue rule calling upon the respondents as to frame and implement the special schemes as recommended by the Committee on Petition of Rajya Sabha, contained in 105<sup>th</sup> report regarding the problems faced by the Indian Chakma Tribal Population/ community in Tripura.

AND

Issue rule calling upon the respondents to show cause as to why the social schemes/packages cannot be provided for the upliftment of the Indian Chakma Tribal population/community in Tripura and further issue a Writ of mandamus directing the Respondents to fulfil the mandate of the 105<sup>th</sup> Committee Reports and formulate special schemes for the upliftment of Chakmas both socially and economically.

- IV. After hearing the parties be pleased to make the rule absolute."

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and also perused the record, we are of the considered view at this point of time, considering the issues involved, it would be prudent that the State itself takes a

decision on the issue raised and also takes action if so required of pursuing the matter with the authorities.

Needful action be taken within a period of three months. We clarify that we have not dealt with the issue on merits and the petition is disposed of reserving liberty to the petitioner to approach the Court, if need so arises.
