Heard Mr. A. De, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner as well as Mr. A. Roy Barman, learned PP appearing for the State-respondent.

This is an application filed under section 439 Cr.P.C. for granting bail to the accused person, namely, Sri Biswajit Debnath, who is in custody for more than 320 days in connection with Melaghar PS case no. 2018/MLG/048 under sections 20 (b)(ii)(c), 25, 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985.

Mr. De, learned counsel submits that, the accused petitioner has been falsely implicated with the case. Mr. De, learned counsel further submits that charge sheet vide no. 04 of 2019 has already been submitted and the trial court has fixed the calendar for recording the evidence.

Mr. Roy Barman, learned Addl. PP in his usual fairness has submitted that the bail application may be considered imposing some stringent conditions.

Having due regard to the submission, I am inclined to release the accused person on bail. Accordingly, in the event of arrest, the accused, namely, Sri Biswajit Debnath may be released on bail on executing a bond of Rs. 50,000/- supported by one surety of the like amount, to the satisfaction of the concerned Special Judge, with further conditions that:

- (i) The accused, shall appear before the investigating officer twice in a week till conclusion of the trial before the Special Judge.
- (ii) The accused, shall appear on each and every dates before the trial court to face the trial.
- (iii) The accused, shall not leave the jurisdiction of the concerned police station without prior permission of the investigating officer.

With this observation and direction, the instant application is allowed and disposed of.
