Petitioner has prayed for the following reliefs:

- (i) Admit this petition;
- (ii) Call for the records from the O/o Respondent No.2;
- (iii) Issue notice upon the Respondents;
- (iv) After hearing both sides, be pleased to pass an order directing the Respondents particularly the Respondent No.2 for appointment of the sole Arbitrator for entering into the reference for settlement of disputes in the instant Arbitration proceeding and further be pleased to pass an order directing the sole Arbitrator to complete the arbitral proceeding within a short time frame as may deem fit and proper;

The application is for appointment of an Arbitrator to take up the arbitration proceedings concerning by Agreement No. 19/F.101/Div-II/AMC/2016 (Annexure-1, Page-11) for the work of "Construction of western side footpath starting from Astabal Bridge upto Radhanagar Bus Stand, ward No.05" (Annexure-2).

After the matter was heard for some time, learned counsel for the parties jointly pray that the matter be referred to the arbitration of Shri S.M. Chakraborty, Sr. Advocate who is best suited to adjudicate the disputes having arisen out of Agreement No.19/F.101/Div-II/AMC/2016.

Thus, as prayed for, the matter is referred to the arbitration of Sri S.M. Chakraborty, Sr. Advocate for adjudicating the

disputes *inter se* the parties, subject matter of Agreement No.19/F.101/Div-II/AMC/2016 executed between the Executive Engineer, Division No-II, Agartala Municipal Corporation and Sri Ranjan Acharjee, S/o. Sri Abani Mohan Acharjee, Netaje Chowmuhani, Agartala, West Tripura.

Parties undertake to appear before the Arbitrator on **26**th **March, 2019** whereafter the learned Arbitrator shall enter reference and try to complete the proceedings as expeditiously as possible in accordance with law.

Parties undertake to fully cooperate and not take any unnecessary adjournments. The Arbitrator shall be entitled for fees and his fees shall be fixed by tripartite agreement among the parties keeping in mind the guidelines specified in the Fourth Schedule to the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 as amended in 2015.

Petition stands disposed of.
