**ORAL:**

By way of present petition filed under Section 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners have sought that in spite of judgment and order dated 22.04.2014 passed by this Court in WP(C) No. 258 of 2011 and judgement and order dated 04.03.2015 passed in WA No.37 of 2014 granting basic pay to the Science teachers of Ad-hoc Aided Secondary Schools, the petitioners have not been granted the benefits of these judgements to the extent of arrears.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that they had filed representation dated 14.01.2019 but the same has not yet been considered by the respondent No.2. Therefore, it was prayed that a time-bound direction may be issued to the respondent to decide the same.

After perusing the writ petition and hearing the learned counsel for the parties, this writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondent No.2 to take a decision on the representation dated 14.01.2019 (Annexure-4) filed by the writ petitioners after affording opportunity of hearing to them and to pass a speaking order within two months from

the date of presentation of a certified copy of this order to respondent No.2 in accordance with law.

Writ petition is disposed of as above.
