Heard Mr. B. Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. N. Sarma, learned Standing Counsel, Secondary Education and Mr. R. Borpujari, learned Standing Counsel, Finance Department for the respondents.

The matter pertains to claim for payment of arrear salary, increment etc. for the period from 01.02.2008 to 16.9.2014 to the petitioner for the services rendered by him as Assistant Teacher in Karia Higher Secondary School. It has been stated by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is due to retire from service in the month of October, 2019.

This Court is of the view that as the matter relates claim of arrear salary, the same can be verified by the authorities and if on verification it is found that the petitioner has actually rendered services, the petitioner should be given the arrear salary for the aforesaid period.

Accordingly, it is directed that the respondent authorities shall verify the claim of the petitioner and if it is found that the petitioner had rendered services for the aforesaid period, necessary orders may be passed releasing the same. The exercise in this behalf shall be undertaken and completed within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
