## **ORDER**

Date: 28-06-2019

Heard Mr. A Tewari, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. NJ Dutta, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, appearing for the State of Assam.

By this application, under Section 439 of the Cr.PC, the petitioner, namely, **Sri Anil Das**, has prayed for granting bail in connection with **Pragjyotishpur PS Case No.** 56/2019 under Sections 376(g)/302/506 of the IPC.

Perused the FIR and the documents annexed with the petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was arrested on

28.03.2019 and in the meantime, the statutory period of 90 (ninety) days has already been over and the charge-sheet has also not been filed and therefore, prays for release of the petitioner on bail.

Since the petitioner has already completed the statutory period and the charge-sheet has also not been filed, he is entitled to default bail. Accordingly, the accused-petitioner, named above, is allowed to be enlarged on bail of Rs. 50,000/- with a suitable surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kamrup (Metro), Guwahati.

The bail application stands disposed of.
