## **ORDER**

- 1. The prayer made in the present petition is for quashing of F.I.R No. 95/2016 dated 05.11.2016 registered at Police Station Manjakote, u/s 366/109 RPC.
- 2. Vide order dated 19.7.2019, the S.H.O, Police Station, Manjakote, was directed to record statement of the petitioner No.2 and respondent No.2 and produce the same before the Court. Today the petitioner No.2 & the respondent No.2 are present in the Court. They have produced copy of the statement, which was recorded before the S.H.O, Police Station, Manjakote. Both the parties stated that the dispute between them has been settled amicably in terms of aforementioned Statement, therefore, the F.I.R No. 95/2016 dated 05.11.2016 registered at Police Station Manjakote, u/s 366/109 RPC be quashed.

3. Once the matter in dispute has been compromised between the parties, no useful purpose will be served by proceeding with the prosecution as the same is likely to fail. It is a case where the petitioner No.1 and the petitioner No.2 - daughter of respondent No.2, had married against his consent. Issue stands resolved. Hence F.I.R No. 95/2016 dated 05.11.2016 registered at Police Station Manjakote, u/s 366/109 RPC and all subsequent proceedings thereto are quashed.

4. The petition is, accordingly, allowed.
