Mr. Ayjaz Lone, learned Deputy Advocate General, waives notice on behalf of the respondent nos. 1 to 4.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondents while issuing the impugned order has not considered the medical ailment of the petitioner as well as the age of retirement. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case the writ petition is disposed of at its threshold stage by providing the petitioner an opportunity to file a representation and respondents may be directed to dispose of the same by considering the claim as projected by the petitioner therein within a certain timeframe, to which course learned counsel for the respondents has no objection.

Accordingly the writ petition is disposed of providing that the petitioner may file a detailed representation during the course of this week before

the Managing Director, J & K State Forest Commission, who on receipt thereof shall consider the claim of the petitioner and pass consideration order on or before 11.10.2019. Till then the operation of the impugned order qua the petitioner shall remain stayed.
