Petitioner is accused in Balidih P.S. Case No. 115 of 2018, registered for the offence under Sections 420, 467, 468, 272, 273, 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 47(a) of the Excise Act.

A supplementary affidavit has been filed on behalf of the petitioner bringing on record the order dated 27.03.2019 passed by Miss Ruchi Dayal, J.M., Bokaro. It appears that charges under Sections 420, 467, 468, 272, 273, 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 47(a) of the Excise Act have been framed against the petitioner on 27.03.2019.

Learned A.P.P. opposed the prayer for bail.

Be that as it may, keeping in view the fact that charges have been framed and trial will take some time, I am inclined to admit the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Bokaro, in connection with Balidih P.S. Case No. 115 of 2018, subject to following conditions:-

(i) Petitioner shall deposit Rs. 2000/- by way of cost in the account of **Army Welfare Fund Battle Casualties being A/C No. 90552010165915, IFSC Code - SYNB0009055, Syndicate Bank, Branch - South Block, Defence Headquarter, New Delhi, Branch Code - 9055** and will submit a receipt of the aforesaid deposition before the court below at the time of furnishing bail bonds.

(ii) Petitioner is further directed that alongwith the bail bonds, he will furnish his Cell number and xerox copy of Aadhar Card in the court below.

Let a copy of order be also communicated to the trial court and also handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.
