No one appears on behalf of the petitioner, whereas Mrs. Lilly Sahay, learned A.P.P. is present.

Earlier also on 17<sup>th</sup> July, 2019 no one appeared on behalf of the petitioner and the case was adjourned to be listed after two weeks.

The petitioner is an accused in a case registered under Sections 302, 120B and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned A.P.P. submits that initially a first information report being Borio (M) P.S. Case No.370 of 2015, corresponding to G.R. No.2 of 2016, was registered under Sections 302 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code against four named accused persons including the petitioner and 10-20 unknown. After investigation of the said case, the police submitted final form in favour of the accused persons including the petitioner due to lack of evidence. Thereafter, a protest petition was filed by the complainant being Complaint Case No.975 of 2017 against four named accused persons including the petitioner and 10-20 unknown, in which the court below has taken cognizance of the offences under Sections 302 and 120B of the Indian Penal Code against them.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner, above named, on bail in connection with Complaint Case No.975 of 2017.

Accordingly, the petitioner's prayer for bail stands rejected.
