Apprehending his arrest, the petitioner has moved this Court for grant of privilege of anticipatory bail in connection with Giridih (T) P.S. Case No.359 of 2017 registered under sections 414/468/471/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Addl. P.P. for the State.

The Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation against the petitioner is that the petitioner has sold a stolen motorcycle to the co-accused persons and the petitioner is involved in business of dealing with stolen motorcycle after making ownership book of the motorcycle. It is further submitted that the allegation against the petitioner are all false and the petitioner has been implicated in this case only on the basis of confessional statement of the co-accused and the petitioner has never sold the motorcycle to the co-accused. It is next submitted that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent as has been mentioned in paragraph no. 16 of the anticipatory bail application. It is then submitted that the petitioner is ready and willing to furnish sufficient security including cash security and undertakes to cooperate with the investigation of the case. Hence, it is submitted that the petitioner be given the privilege of anticipatory bail.

Learned Addl. P.P. opposes the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail.

Considering the submissions of the counsels and the fact as discussed above, I am of the opinion that it is a fit case where the above named petitioner be given the privilege of anticipatory bail. Hence, in the event of his arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from the date of this order, he shall be released on bail on depositing cash security of Rs.10,000/- and on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Giridih, in connection with Giridih (T) P.S. Case No.359 of 2017 with the condition that the petitioner will cooperate with the investigation of the case and appear before the Investigating Officer as and when noticed by him and will furnish his mobile number and a copy of his Aadhar Card in the court below with the undertaking that he will not change his mobile number during the pendency of the case subject to the conditions laid down under section 438 (2) Cr. P.C.
