

2. 28.06.2019 Heard Shri S.K. Bhanjadeo, learned counsel for the petitioner and Shri B. Behera, learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State-opposite parties.

Considering the allegation involved in this matter and as a decision in such matter is ultimately required to be taken by the Tahasildar in exercise of power under the O.P.L.E. Act, this matter stands disposed of with a direction to the Tahasildar, Begunia, Dist.-Khordha to look into the grievance of the petitioner vide Annexure-7 to this writ petition and make an enquiry involving the parties. It is directed that upon entering into an enquiry, if the Tahasildar, Begunia, Dist.-Khordha observes, there is unauthorized occupation over the Govt. land, the Tahasildar shall initiate an appropriate proceeding following the provisions contained in the O.P.L.E. Act against the unauthorized encroachers and decide the same within a period of two months thereafter, but however, giving opportunity of hearing to the parties likely to be affected.

Since the order is passed at the admission stage petitioner is directed to produce a certified copy of this order along with a copy of the brief before the Tahasildar, Begunia, Dist.-Khordha within a week hence for his/her proceeding in the matter.

Issue urgent certified copy on proper application.
