Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State.

This is an application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for anticipatory bail.

Perused the copy of the F.I.R. attached to the bail petition.

Considered the materials placed by learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioners are stated to be the members of the family of the in-laws of the informant. They are implicated in the offence punishable under Sections 498-A / 323 /354/354-B/ 307 /506/34, I.P.C and under Section 4 of D.P. Act.

Taking into consideration the facts and submission, nature of allegation, factum of permanent residence of the petitioners and the fact that there is always a hope of compromise between the parties in matrimonial dispute and such compromise is always beneficial for the interest of the family and society, it is directed that, each of the petitioners shall surrender before the learned J.M.F.C., Jajpur Road, and apply for bail in connection with Korei P.S. Case No. 168 of 2019 corresponding to C.T. Case No. 1014 of 2019 within

15 (fifteen) days from today. In the event of their surrender and motion for bail, learned J.M.F.C., Jajpur Road shall release each of the petitioners on bail on such terms and conditions as deemed just and proper.

The ABLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
