Petitioner seeks following reliefs:-

“i) That, the respondents be commanded to consider the representation contained in Annexure -P/1 with a further to promote the petitioner over the post of Inspector keeping in view he has been acquitted from criminal case and his case was included in fit list of promotion with a further to issue order of promotion granting seniority over and above to the incumbent junior Harveer Singh with a further direction to extend all consequential benefits, in the interest of justice.

ii) That, any other relief which is suitable in the facts and circumstances of the case in favour of the petitioner including the costs throughout may also be granted.”

It is borne out from the record that in respect of the reliefs sought, the petitioner has already preferred a representation forming subject matter of Annexure P-1 and P-7.

As the petitioner has already invoked departmental remedy, instead of dwelling on the merits and the grievance raised by the petitioner, petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 i.e. Director General of Police to decide the representation of the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of communication of this order.

It is reiterated that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the matter. Petitioner along with the copy of the order passed today shall also place the copy of the memo of petition along
