has not been decided till now.

Counsel for the State fairly submits that there is no objection in deciding the petitioner's representation within a

time bound period.

Having regard to the aforesaid, without adverting to the merits of the matter, the writ petition is **disposed off** by directing the respondent No.3 to take an appropriate decision on the petitioner's representation in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
