

**The High Court Of Madhya Pradesh****WP-8244-2019***(SHRIRAM YADAV Vs THE STATE OF MADHYA PRADESH)***Jabalpur, Dated : 30-04-2019**

The petitioner has filed this petition challenging the order dated 25/09/2018 (Annexure P/4) passed by respondent no.5/CEO, Janpad Panchayat, Prithwipur, District-Niwari.

The contention of the petitioner is that the order has been passed by an incompetent authority i.e. CEO, however, it is fairly submitted that petitioner has already filed an appeal before the appellate authority which is pending consideration.

Learned GA appearing for the respondents/State has invited attention of this Court to circular dated 03.06.2017 passed by Commissioner, M.P. State Rozgar Guarantee Parishad, Bhopal which prescribes that CEO is the competent authority to pass an order against Gram Rozgar Sahayak.

However, considering the fact that an appeal is pending consideration before the respondent/authority, the respondent/authority is directed to decide the same within a period of 45 days from the date of filing of certified copy of the order passed today.

It is made clear that this Court has not opined on the merits of the case.

With the aforesaid direction, the petition stands disposed of.
