This is first application under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of bail filed on behalf of the applicant-Vinay Kumar **Gupta** who is in jail since 02.05.2019 in connection with Crime No. 89/19 registered at Police Station Lok Ayukt Office, District Sagar for offence under Sections 306 read with Sections 34 and 13(1)(d) r/w 13(2) of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 for taking bribe of Rs. 50,000/from complainant-Shivhari.

Learned counsel applicant submits for the that the investigation/trial will take considerable time, hence prayer is made to enlarge applicant on bail.

Learned counsel for the respondent has vehemently opposed the bail application, but has stated that the investigation would take some time.

Looking to the facts and circumstances of the case, without commenting upon the merits of the case, I am inclined to allow the instant application. It is directed that the applicant be enlarged on bail upon his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand Only) with one solvent surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court for his appearance before the trial Court on the dates so fixed by that Court during the trial.

The applicant shall abide by the following conditions of Section 437(3) of Cr.P.C. as under:

- (a) that such person shall attend in accordance with the conditions of the bond executed under this Chapter,
- (b) that such person shall not commit any offence similar to the offence of which he is accused, or suspected, of the commission of which he is suspected, and
- (c) that such person shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer or tamper with the evidence.

With the aforesaid, this M.Cr.C. stands allowed and disposed of. Certified copy as per rules.
