The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the payment has been released by the respondents to the petitioners and the only issue which remains relates to recovery of interest for which the petitioners may be granted liberty to raise a dispute in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract.

In view of the statement of the learned counsel for the petitioners, the petitions filed by the petitioners stand disposed of granting liberty to the petitioners to raise a dispute relating to recovery of interest in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract.

It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the matter and therefore, the respondent authorities would be at liberty to examine the matter keeping all facts and facets into consideration and thereafter take a decision in accordance with law.

With the aforesaid liberty, the petitions filed by the petitioners stand disposed of.
