The petitioner is aggrieved by the order dated 09.11.2019 (Annexure-P/1) whereby she is transferred from Balaghat to Dindori. Apart from other grounds, it is urged that petitioner's husband is a Government employee was recently transferred from Chhindwara to Balaghat on 22.06.2019. As far as possible the spouse should be posted at the same place.

Considering the aforesaid, I deem it proper to dispose of this petition with following directions :-

(i) Petitioner shall re-submit her representation dated 11.11.2019 with relevant documents and copy of this order and submit it before respondent No. 2 within 10 working days' from today, failing which the interim protections will not be available to the petitioner.

(ii) In turn, respondent No. 2 shall consider and decide the representation of the petitioner in accordance with law and take a decision expeditiously.

(iii) Subject to aforesaid, till decision is taken on the petitioner's representation, the impugned order dated 09.11.2019 (Annexure-P/1), so far as it relates to the petitioner, shall remain stayed.

Petition is disposed of without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case.
