This first bail application under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed by the applicant in connection with Crime No.733/2019 registered at Police Station City Kotwali, District Chhindwara for the offence punishable under Sections 376(2)(N), 452 and 376(1) of IPC.

The learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has not committed any offence and he has been falsely implicated. The applicant is in custody since 03.11.2019. Therefore, prayed for grant of bail.

Per contra, the learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondent/State opposed the application and prayed for its rejection.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, without commenting any opinion on the merits of the case, I am inclined to grant bail to the applicant, therefore, the application of the applicant is allowed.

It is directed that the applicant be released on bail on his furnishing personal bond in the sum of **Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand)** with one solvent surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the JMFC concerned or the trial Court for his
