

The High Court Of Madhya Pradesh**WP-28916-2019***(O.P. SHARMA Vs THE STATE OF MADHYA PRADESH AND OTHERS)***Jabalpur, Dated : 30-12-2019**

I.A. No.16033/2019, an application for urgent hearing during the winter vacation is allowed for the reasons mentioned therein.

Heard on the question of admission.

By the instant petition, the petitioner is challenging transfer order dated 23.11.2019 (Annexure-P-3) whereby he has been directed to be transferred from Govt. Girls Higher Secondary School Timarani to Govt. Middle School Singoda, District Harda.

The petitioner has assailed the order of transfer on diverse grounds seeking quashment of the same.

Since the representation dated (Annexure-P/6) of the petitioner is pending consideration before the authorities, therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of directing the respondents/authorities to consider and decide the pending representation (Annexure-P/6) of the petitioner taking note of the grievance of the petitioner.

Let the authorities shall take a decision in accordance with law within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that if the petitioner has not been relieved and nobody has been brought in place of the petitioner, then the petitioner shall not be compelled to join at the transferred place for a period of 30 days.
