[1] **Rule.** Learned APP waives service of notice of rule for and on behalf of respondent-State.

[2] This bail application is filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for regular bail in connection with an offence being C.R.No.I-36 of 2019 registered with Joravarnagar Police Station, Dist.-Surendranagar for the offence punishable under Sections 307, 506(2), 120(B), 212, 114 of the IPC and Section 25(1)(1-b)(a), 27 of Arms Act and Section 135 of the G.P.Act and etc.

[3] Learned advocate appearing on behalf of the applicant submits that considering the nature of offence, the applicant may be enlarged on regular bail by imposing suitable conditions.

[4] Learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of the respondent-State has

opposed grant of regular bail looking to the nature and gravity of the offence.

[5] I have heard learned advocates appearing on behalf of the respective parties and perused the papers of investigation. I have considered the fact that limited role is revealing against the present applicant with the crime in question.

[6] In the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the nature of allegations made against the applicant in the FIR, without discussing the evidence in detail, *prima facie*, this Court is of the opinion that this is a fit case to exercise the discretion and enlarge the applicant on regular bail. Hence, the present application is allowed and the applicant is ordered to be released on **regular bail** in connection with an offence being **C.R.No.I-36 of 2019 registered with Joravarnagar Police Station, Dist.-Surendranagar** on executing a personal bond of **Rs.10,000/-** (Rupees Ten thousand only) with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Trial Court and subject to the conditions that he shall;

- [a] not take undue advantage of liberty or misuse liberty;
- [b] not act in a manner injurious to the interest of the prosecution;
- [c] surrender passport, if any, to the lower court within a week;
- [d] not leave India without prior permission of

the Sessions Judge concerned;

[e] mark presence before the concerned Police Station on alternate Monday for initial three months and thereafter, on first Monday of every English calendar month, for a further period of three months, between 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.;

[f] furnish latest address of residence to the Investigating Officer and also to the Court at the time of execution of the bond and shall not change the residence without prior permission of the trial Court;

[7] The Authorities will release the applicant only if he is not required in connection with any other offence for the time being. If breach of any of the above conditions is committed, the Sessions Judge concerned will be free to issue warrant or take appropriate action in the matter. Bail bond to be executed before the learned Lower Court having jurisdiction to try the case. It will be open for the concerned Court to delete, modify and/or relax any of the above conditions, in accordance with law. At the trial, learned Trial Court shall not be influenced by the observations of preliminary nature, qua the evidence at this stage, made by this Court while enlarging the applicant on bail. Rule is made absolute to the aforesaid extent.

Direct service is permitted.
