CRIMINAL PETITION No. 2022 OF 2019

ORDER:

This criminal petition, under Sections 437 and 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, is filed by the petitioner-accused No. 2 seeking for grant of bail to him in crime No. 16 of 2019 of Chinturu Police Station, East Godavari District, registered for the offence punishable under Section 8 (c) read with Section 20 (b) (ii) (C) of NDPS Act.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Public Prosecutor.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner involved in an offence in the year 2014 and after 2014, he never involved in any other offence and that due to his financial problems, the petitioner agreed to transport Ganja by taking Rs.10,000/-. But, the fact remains that in spite of the petitioner being involved in other offence, he did not change his behaviour and he again got into transportation of Ganja. Hence, considering the above, this Court opines that it is not a fit case to grant bail to the petitioner.

4. The criminal petition is accordingly dismissed. Pending miscellaneous petitions, if any, shall stand dismissed in consequence.
