1. The questions raised in this petition relate to disputed facts and necessarily trial should go on in respect thereof. In such an event, a petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C cannot be maintained. In the course of hearing, the learned counsel for the petitioners requested to direct that the appearance of the petitioners be dispensed with in the trial Court.
