HONOURABLE SMT. JUSTICE KONGARA VIJAYA LAKSHMI WRIT PETITION No.18130 of 2019

ORDER:

This writ petition is filed to "declare the action of the respondents in not allotting duties to the petitioner in pursuance of the disengagement due to curtailment of schedules even after the vacancies arises, and depriving the livelihood of the petitioner, in pursuance of the proceedings No.E1/255(16)14-RM-Q, dated 09.10.2014 as illegal, arbitrary and contrary to APSRTC Regulations".

The case of the petitioner is that he was appointed as Driver in APSRTC in the year 2007 on contract basis and worked for about three years; initially they appoint the candidates on contract basis and after completion of 240 days they will be regularized in a phased manner; due to curtailment of schedules, the petitioner, while working in 3rd respondent Depot, was disengaged from service; in similar circumstances this Court disposed of batch of writ petitions being W.P.No.2786 of 2011 and batch directing the respondents to reinstate the petitioners therein by quashing the impugned termination orders; as the petitioner is also similarly situated person, he submitted representations to the 2nd respondent on 03.01.2019 and to the 1st respondent on 19.03.2019, but no action has been taken so far. Hence the present writ petition.

Without going into the merits of the case, since the petitioner has already submitted representation to the 2nd respondent on 03.01.2019, the 2nd respondent is directed to dispose of the representation submitted by the petitioner, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, if the same is received and is pending before him.
