JUDGMENT

The petitioner has filed this Contempt Case alleging non-compliance of the directions contained in Annexure A1 judgment of this Court dated 18.07.2018 in W.P.(C) No.23451 of 2018, whereby that writ petition was disposed of by directing the respondent to sanction and disburse all admissible pension and other pensionary benefits payable to the petitioner, as expeditiously as possible, at any rate within a period of six weeks from the date of production of a certified copy of this judgment, if there is no other legal impediment standing in the way.

2. On 01.11.2018, when this Contempt Case came up for admission, the learned Standing Counsel sought time for getting instructions. On 26.11.2018, when this Contempt Case taken up for consideration, this Court passed the following:

“The learned Standing Counsel for KSRTC would point out that sanctioning and disbursement of terminal benefits payable to the petitioner in terms of the direction contained in Annexure A1 judgment of this Court is delayed on account of non-regularisation of the period of service of the petitioner for certain period.”

3. Today, when this case is taken up for consideration, it is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the respondent has already complied with the directions contained in

Annexure A1 judgment dated 18.07.2018.

Recording the above submission, this Contempt Case is closed.
