JUDGMENT

This writ petition is filed by the petitioner seeking the following reliefs:

i) Issue a writ of mandamus or appropriate writ or direction directing the 3rd respondent to approve the appointment of the petitioner as HSST (Music) w.e.f. 04.07.2001, as directed in Ext.P2 and further direct to draw and disburse the salary and all consequential benefits to the petitioner in the post of HSST.

ii) Issue appropriate order or direction as this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to deem fit.

Apparently, the issue in this writ petition relates to the approval of the appointment of the petitioner as HSST. However, today when the matter is taken up, learned Senior Government Pleader submitted that, petitioner's appointment as HSST is approved on and with effect from 04.07.2001 as per order dated 09.10.2019.

2. In that view of the matter, I think it is only appropriate that, writ petition is disposed of with suitable directions.

3. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Senior Government Pleader, this writ petition is disposed of recording that, service of the petitioner as HSST is already approved on and with effect from 04.07.2001 as per Government Order Dated 09.10.2019.

4. Needless to say, all other service benefits flowing out of the same shall be paid to the petitioner, including arrears of pay and other benefits at the earliest, and at any rate, within 3 months from the date of receipt of a copy of this judgment.
