
COMMON JUDGMENT

This appeals have been filed to set aside the orders passed in C.C.Nos.115, 117 and 118 of 2002 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Padmanapuram, Kanyakumari District dated 18.09.2009.

2.On the side of the appellant, it is stated that after the filing of the appeals, there is an amendment under Section 372 of Cr.P.C., as to appeal remedy is available to the District and Sessions Court and prayed the case to be remitted back to the District and Sessions Court, Nagercoil.
