THE HON'BLE DR.JUSTICE SHAMEEM AKTHER CRIMINAL PETITION No.284 OF 2019

ORDER:

This Criminal Petition, under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, is filed by the petitioner/A.1, for grant of anticipatory bail in Crime No.172 of 2018 of Manthani Police Station, Peddapalli District, registered for the offence punishable under Section 420 read with 34 of IPC.

- 2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner/A.1, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor representing the respondent-State and perused the record.
- 3. Learned counsel for the petitioner/A.1 would contend that the petitioner is only a car driver. He has nothing to do with the money of Rs.9,00,000/- alleged to have taken away from the *de facto* complainant-Y.Ramesh and disappearance of the same as mentioned in the report lodged with the police and ultimately prayed to allow the petition.
- 4. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor representing the respondent/State opposed the grant of bail to the petitioner/A.1 and ultimately, prayed to dismiss the petition.
- 5. As per the FIR, dated 06.10.2018, the petitioner/A.1 along with other accused made the *de facto* complainant-Y.Ramesh to believe that on performing poojas, etc., the money would be doubled and the *de facto* complainant gave an amount of Rs.9,00,000/-. This petitioner and other accused took cash of Rs.9,00,000/- and absconded from the scene of offence when the *de facto* complainant

went to submerge the coconuts, etc., in Godavari river at Godavari

khani.

6. There are specific and grave allegations against the

petitioner/A.1 and other accused in this case regarding their running

away with Rs.9,00,000/- belonging to the de facto complainant. The

matter requires custodial interrogation. Hence, it is not a fit case to

allow the petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C.

7. In the result, the Criminal Petition is dismissed.
