AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The petitioners filed a writ petition being aggrieved of the action of the Punjab Tourism Development Corporation Ltd., with regard to dispute of pensionary benefits. The writ petition was disposed with the direction to decide the representation by passing an order after providing opportunity of hearing.

The contempt petition has been preferred raising grievance that order dated 16.10.2018 was passed deciding the representation, without providing opportunity of hearing to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the respondent states that fresh

order would be passed after providing opportunity of hearing to the petitioners.

The contempt petition is disposed of in view of statement made by learned counsel for State.
