On 22.04.2019, following order was passed:-

“Loveleen Kaur and Satnam Singh, the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have got married against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 6 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents No.4 to 6. They have placed on record photographs (Annexure P-3) evidencing their marriage. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 17.04.2019 (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.2.

Mr. Ramdeep Partap Singh, DAG, Punjab, appearing for the State of Punjab, is requested to submit a status report. A copy of the petition be supplied to the State Counsel during the course of the day.

In the meantime, respondent No.2 would examine the

threat perceptions and if found necessary, interim protection would be provided to them. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.

Adjourned to 26.04.2019. ”

Counsel representing State of Punjab has submitted that the petitioners have now given statements to the police that they do not have any apprehension to their life and liberty. Apart therefrom, statement of mother and brother of petitioner No.1 has been recorded who have accepted the marriage and have assured the police that they would not cause any disturbance in the married life of the petitioners.

In view thereof, the present petition is disposed of.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to file fresh petition if they feel any threat perceptions.
